Leisa Wintz is a family law attorney, managing partner of Family Matters Law Group, P.A., and the founder of Boss Lady Esquire, a platform dedicated to supporting and mentoring female attorneys in law firm ownership and business management. With a background in family therapy and law, Leisa brings a unique perspective to her work, combining legal expertise with a deep understanding of family dynamics.

In 2017, Leisa found herself in a challenging position when she unexpectedly had to take over full management of her law firm with only five days' notice. Up until that point, she had primarily focused on litigation and marketing, while her former partner handled the firm's operations and finances. Suddenly, she had to navigate every aspect of running a law firm— alone—while also balancing life as a mother of two young children.

Searching for guidance, she quickly realized that most available resources for law firm owners were either prohibitively expensive or required long-term commitments, making them inaccessible for many women attorneys trying to build or sustain their own firms. Recognizing this gap, Leisa took matters into her own hands and created Boss Lady Esquire—a community where female attorneys could connect, share knowledge, and support one another through the challenges of running a law firm.

What started as a small support group quickly grew into a national movement, and today, Boss Lady Esquire offers mentorship, training, and resources specifically designed for women in law. The platform provides:

- Educational courses on law firm management, marketing, finances, and leadership.
- A network of experienced attorneys willing to share what works in their own firms.
- A supportive community where female lawyers can ask questions and receive real, practical advice.

While Leisa remains deeply involved in mentoring and supporting women attorneys through Boss Lady Esquire, she continues to serve as managing partner at Family Matters Law Group, P.A., where she primarily works as a mediator and guardian ad litem. In these roles, she focuses on helping families resolve disputes amicably and ensuring that the best interests of children are protected in complex family law cases.

Through her work at Family Matters Law Group and her leadership at Boss Lady Esquire, Leisa has become a powerful advocate for both her clients and her fellow attorneys. She is passionate about helping women build successful, sustainable law firms without the financial burden of expensive coaching programs. Her journey is a testament to resilience, innovation, and the power of community, proving that when women attorneys support each other, success is inevitable.
